## **Children's book tells true story of Windsor pilot**

A new children's book from a Windsor publishing house rolls off the presses this fall.

Titled *A Bad Penny Always Returns*, the illustrated children's book from Walkerville Publishing Inc. appeals to kids from grades 1 to 4.

Based on a true story from the Second World War, the book follows a Lancaster bomber's dangerous test mission over enemy territory to Holland, dropping food bundles for people who were starving. Named *Bad Penny*, the Lancaster was piloted by Windsor's Bill Upcott.

The successful flight helped launch Operation Manna, involving thousands of pounds of food supplies shipped by the Allies during May, 1945.

"We think this book would be of tremendous interest to pupils in Windsor, their teachers and their parents and grandparents," says Elaine Weeks, Walkerville Publishing's managing editor.

Written by Glen Mitchell, the book is illustrated by Kristen Gallerneaux. The 32-page book is published in full colour; hardcover books are coming in October and softcover books are available now.
